I-40 West to Rt. 29, Rt. 29 North to Rt. 58, Rt. 58 west to Martinsville & Collinsville, Rt. 220 North to Roanoke to I-581, From I-581 follow directions from Roanoke

From Richmond

Mileage: 180

I-64 West to exit 87 (this will put you on I-81 north)

I-81 north to exit 222 (you will only be on I-81 north about 1/4 of a mile) Exit 222 will put you on Rt. 250 West, Rt. 250 West to Rt. 254 West (both of these routes will be in Staunton), Rt. 254 west to Rt. 42 South
