After leaving terminal, exit on 528 (the Beeline) going West. Take the Beeline to Interstate-4. Go West towards Walt Disney World. Exit Interstate-4 at exit 27 (Lake Buena Vista/Kissimmee). At bottom of exit ramp, go right (535). At first stop light (Hotel Plaza Blvd.), go left (pass Downtown Disney hotels). Go to stop light (Buena Vista Drive) and make a right. Wyndham Palace Resort & Spa is on the right (27-story Palace).

From Ft. Lauderdale/Miami

Turnpike/North to the Interstate-4 Orlando Exit. Go West on Interstate-4 at exit 27 (Lake Buena Vista/Kissimmee). At bottom of exit ramp, go right (535). At first stop light (Hotel Plaza Blvd.), go left (pass Downtown Disney hotels). Go to stop light (Buena Vista Drive) and make a right. Wyndham Palace Resort & Spa is on the right (27-story Palace).

From Tampa

Interstate-4 (towards Orlando). Exit Interstate-4 at exit 27. At bottom of exit ramp, go right (535). At first stop light (Hotel Plaza Blvd.), go left (pass Downtown Disney hotels). Go to stop light (Buena Vista Drive) and make a right. Wyndham Palace Resort & Spa is on the right (27-story Palace).

From Daytona

Interstate-4 East (towards Tampa). Go past Orlando. Exit Interstate-4 at exit 27. At bottom of exit ramp, go right (535). At first stop light (Hotel Plaza Blvd.), go left (pass Downtown Disney hotels). Go to stop light (Buena Vista Drive) and make a right. Wyndham Palace Resort & Spa is on the right (27-story Palace).

From Georgia

Interstate-75 South (towards Florida). Exit at the Florida Turnpike exit in Leesburg, Florida. Take Turnpike South to Interstate-4, exit in Orlando. Get on Interstate-4 West (towards the Attractions). Exit Interstate-4 at exit 27. At bottom of exit ramp, go right (535).
